INSTRUCTIONS

1. For full instructions see pars. 7 to 10, Chap. 7, and Appendix C, TM 19-500.
2. This report replaces WD AGO Form 19-21 (1 Apr 45) and WD PMG Form 27, rev.
3. Note that the report will require daily classification of prisoners as "workers" and "nonworkers." Prisoners on *essential* unpaid labor are workers and will be reported in Item 3a, Part I, and under Project Code 10, Part II.
4. Rest days are reported only for prisoners who are classified as workers. For each calendar week the number of rest days reported in Section 4 will equal approximately one-seventh of the total man-days (including rest days) of workers shown on the line following Section 4.
5. Before mailing this report, verify the addition, and the consistency of the following items: (a) Total man-days shown in Part I, Section 1 must equal the sum of man-days for nonworkers, Section 2, plus workers, Sections 3 and 4. (b) Total man-days

- worked, Item 3a, must equal total man-days shown in the recapitulation of Part II.
6. Where installation names are required, i. e., for service command activities at other posts, for technical services activities, for Army Air Forces activities, and for Navy work, identify the using installation by name. Do not give the name of an individual or subordinate agency thereof.
7. Prisoners on service command activities at technical services installations will be reported under project codes 10 to 19 for prisoner of war camp overhead, and project codes 22 or 23 for other service command activities.
8. Submit 2 reports each month: One for the period from 1st to 15th, inclusive, the other for period 16th to end of month. Mail one copy direct to Office of The Provost Marshal General, Washington 25, D. C., Attention: Prisoner of War Operations Division, to reach that office within 6 days from end of reporting period.
