On Saturday Syt. Deva Prakash Nayar came to our office with the manuscripts of Gandhiji's Prayer Speeches sent back by Dr. Sushila Nayar. He reported on her behalf that the transcription has not been done properly and the manuscripts must be revised with the help of the records in A.I.R. and sent back to Dr. Sushila Nayar for editing on 22nd May with Dr. Jivaraj Mehta or Dr. Gilder who are to go to see Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. It has been stressed by her that the publication of Gandhiji's Prayer Speeches should be authentic and complete and the matter should be taken up in hand immediately as she is to leave Mussorie in near future and will leave India by 25th June 1948 for America.
